Summary

1. Climate change can have negative effects on crop production, crop nutrition, and human and animal health;
2. The 'weather' reflects short-term conditions of the atmosphere while the 'climate' is the average weather over a 30-year time span;
3. Agrometeorological information can aid in reducing weather-related risks in agricultural production and is critical in planning climate smart agriculture strategies and interventions.
